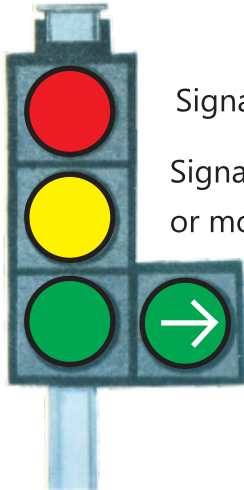

Signal to stop.

Signal to ready to stop

and taking turn



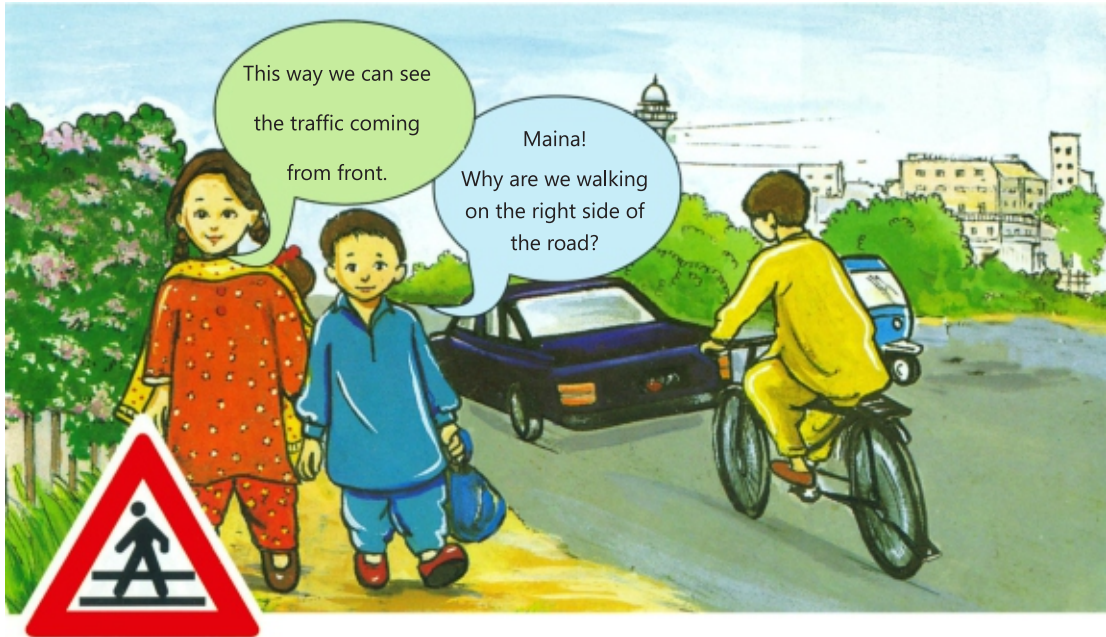
traffic signs

In the absence of traffic signals, we should follow traffic sergeant's signals.



Pedestrian path

While walking on the road, always use footpaths.



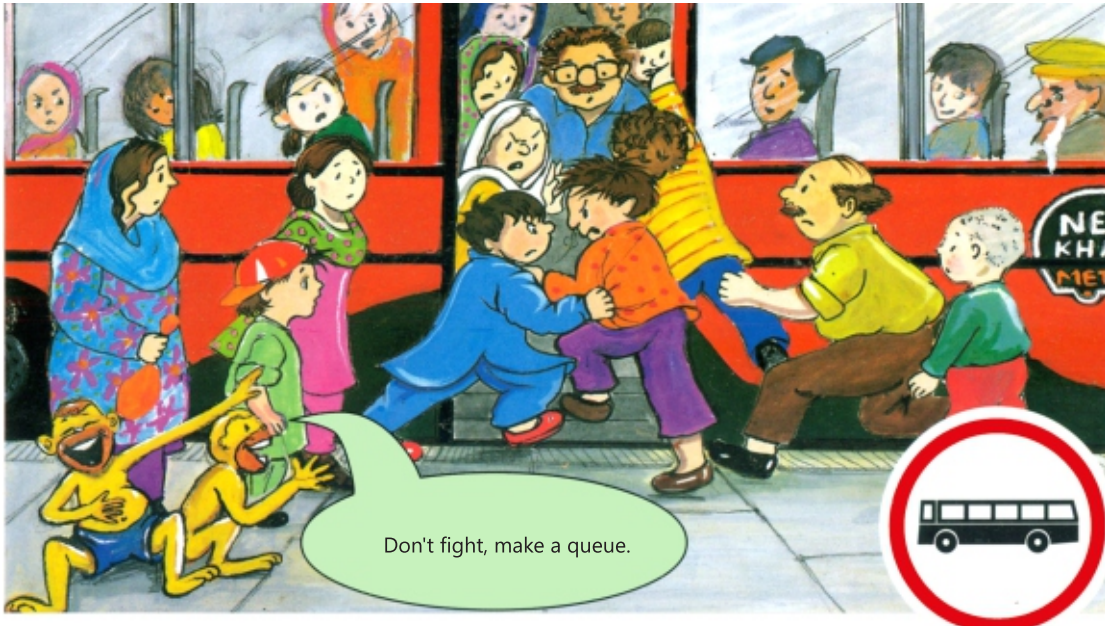
Pedestrian path

Walk on the right side of the road when there is no footpath.



Use zebra crossing while crossing the road.

Zebra crossing



Make a queue and wait for your turn.

Bus stop



Roads are for traffic and not for playing.

- (iii) Which side of the road should we walk on, if there is no footpath?



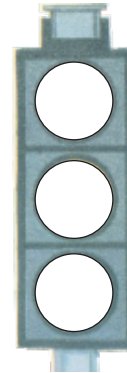
