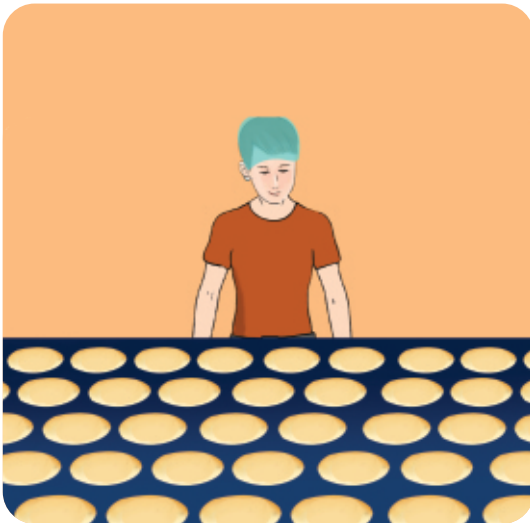
Agriculture and Animal Farming

Bread (roti) is prepared from the flour at home. Biscuits are also prepared by mixing some other items in the flour.

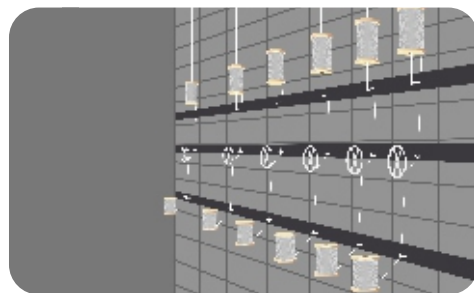




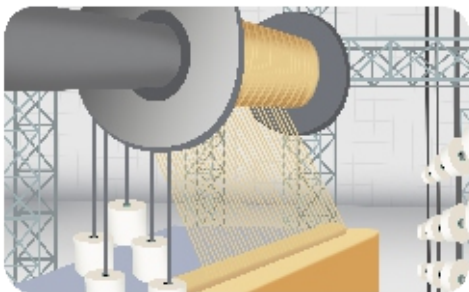
The farmer grows cotton crop.
