The people living in homes around us are called neighbours.



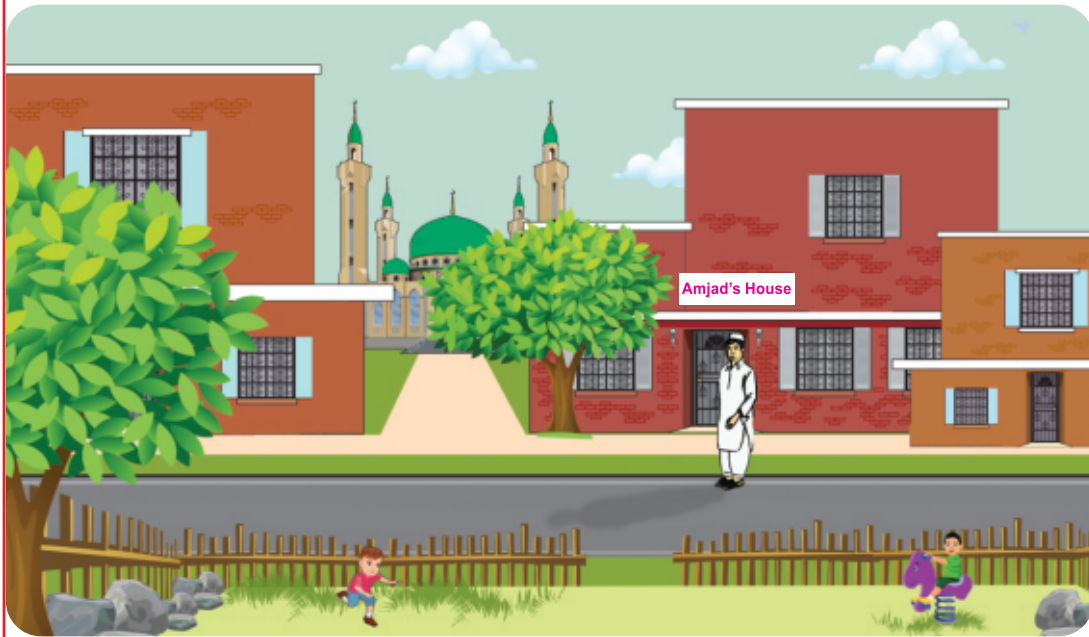
The children of these homes are our friends. We play together in the evening everyday. We also help each other in our studies. If someone cooks a delicious dish, it is shared with the neighbours.
